

Stay smart

The HKT Smart Living Awards once again show what the future of smart interior design might have in store

The 2019 iteration of the HKT Smart Living Awards honoured eight interior designers and 11 students at a presentation ceremony at The Mills, Tsuen Wan, in September. The awards programme was founded in 2017 as the first of its kind in Hong Kong to promote smart living solutions based on the latest technologies and the increasingly vital role they play in residential projects.

This year, the scope was expanded to include design projects completed overseas, as well as in Hong Kong. The response was overwhelming and attracted more than 120 entries from both professional interior designers and students.

Projects entered were judged by a distinguished panel that included James Law, JP, Chairman & CEO of James Law Cybertecture; Antony Chan, Creative Director of CREAM; Joey Ho, Design Partner of PAL Design

Group; and Ringo Ng, Managing Director of HKT's Consumer Group.

Across all categories, the awards included the HKT Smart Living Design Award; Best Application of Smart Living Concept Award; Best Interior Design Concept Award; and Most Popular Smart Living Design Award.

This was the second year of the scheme's Student category, which adopted the theme "Live Smart. Live Well", and entrants were asked to design a healthy and intelligent living space. The category was particularly well subscribed, with the number of entrants double that of last year.

Designs were judged against two criteria – interior design concept (creative, visual and spatial design) and smart living concept (application of technologies and functionality). The winning projects proved to be highly feasible and innovative in nature. P
